## Safe Cycle Program Year 3 – 6

Dear Parents/Carers,

Duffy Primary School is excited to be starting the Safe Cycle program for the second year. For the next 6 weeks, students will be participating in 1 or 2 practical bike lessons a week.

As we only have access to 12 bikes, students are encouraged to bring their own bike and helmet to school on the days that their class is scheduled. Below is the timetable to show which day for each class/year group. The lessons may change days due to other school activities and teachers may choose to include extra days for their class to use the bikes. We aim to notify students of any changes prior to their lesson.

Students are encouraged to ride to and from school on the day of their lesson. There will be occasions where students will get another day of riding and classes will be informed by their teacher.
