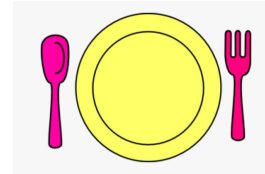
Geography

Look at a map of the world and talk about some connections you have to places around the world.



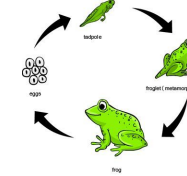
Family time
