



Year 3 Literacy

Below are some fun ideas for your home learning. See how many you can complete with your family! Feel free to keep a record of the tasks you do.

Log on to www.readingeggs.com and complete a reading eggs activity each day. See how many eggs you can collect.

Write a journal entry every day. You may write as a diary of your experiences, or use one of the writing prompts from the back of your writing book.

Read for 20 mins each day. This may be reading to a family member (including a little brother or sister!), recording yourself reading on a device or simply reading to yourself.

Spend 10 minutes looking through different texts everyday to find interesting words. Add any **WOW!** words that you find to your **Word Jar**. If you find a word that you don't know the meaning of, ask an adult or use a dictionary.

Teach a family member to play hangman. Use some of the interesting **WOW!** Words from your **Word Jar** to play with.

Write a list of as many reasons as you can to convince me why your family is the **BEST** family ever!
Try to use modal verbs to write your argument as a letter.

Write a list of 20 adjectives that could be used to describe a fish.
BONUS: Write a list of 20 verbs that could describe something a fish could do.
