Salaka - Sharing the Spirit of Africa Interactive Drumming Concert

Dear Parents/Carers,

Later this term *African Beat* will be coming to Duffy Primary School to perform for students. The show is a highly interactive, and hands-on, culturally rich, informative, professional presentation by authentic visiting artists from Ghana, West Africa (see <http://africanbeat.com.au/> for more details). They will bring enough drums to our school so that every student will learn and play an African rhythm. Students will also learn a traditional African song to accompany the drumming rhythm, and experience African dancing. Students will learn about African instruments, hear stories of African children growing up in the villages and witness traditional African dances as they are performed in Ghana.
