Decide what features make it a living thing.</p>
<p>Retell stories</p> <p>Retell stories read to by using the beginning, middle and end. You can do this orally or draw pictures to match.</p>	<p>Movement breaks</p> <p>Can you make your body look like the letters in the alphabet? Start with the letters in your name, hold the shape for 10 seconds and then make the next letter.</p>	<p>PE</p> <p>Do some jumping, running, galloping and hopping.</p> <p>Make a circuit in your home or backyard with different challenges e.g. gallop to the tree, do 5 hops, run to the fence, do five jumps.</p>	<p>Sorting</p> <p>Sort your toys by type, or colour. How else can you sort things at home? What else can you sort at home?</p>
