Transport: Parents to organise transport to and from the venue
Food: Students will need to bring fruit break, lunch and a water bottle.
There will be a canteen available for lunch, drinks and snacks.
What to Wear: Players will need to wear their school shirt, shorts, socks, appropriate footwear (sneakers) and hat. Sunscreen will be provided but an application prior to arriving is also advised. Students can bring their own cricket bat if they wish.

Please complete the permission note (new players will also need the Medical note) and return it to your child's teacher **no later than Monday 20 November 2017**.

Staff accompanying students on excursions will take all reasonable care while the students are in their charge to protect them from injury and to control and supervise their behaviour and activities.

Parents should be aware that staff members are not responsible for injuries or damage to property, which may occur on an excursion where, in all circumstances, staff have not been negligent.
