We would appreciate donations of clean items (of household waste) for use in the Maker Space. Suggested items include:

- Boxes (e.g. cereal and shoe boxes)
- Plastic containers
- Foam (for example from packaging)
- Plastic and cardboard tubes (not toilet paper rolls)
- Bread bag ties
- Broken toys (we can repurpose the parts)
- Cardboard
- Small pieces of wood (smaller than A4)
- Pieces of dowel
- Wool and fabric
- Tin cans
