

Excursion Information for Parents

Dear Parents and Carers,

Your child has shown an interest to participate in a Cricket Blast School Cup on **in Week 5 this term**. The gala day is organised by Cricket NSW and teams in Year 3/4 and Year 5/6 division. The boys gala day will be held on Tuesday 10 August and the girls gala day will be on Thursday 12 August.

The Cricket School Cup is an optional activity for students who are interested in being part of a Duffy Primary School sporting team. ***Students will require private transport both to and from the venue to participate.***

Dates: Boys – Tuesday 10 August 2021
Girls – Thursday 12 August 2021

Time: Arrive by 9am. Finished for collection at 2:30pm.

Venue: Deakin 2 (6 Makin Place, Deakin)

Purpose of excursion: Cricket Gala Day

Clothing and Equipment: Players will need to wear hat, sunscreen, SunSmart clothing (covered shoulders), Duffy school uniform and appropriate footwear. Cricket NSW will provide equipment

Transport: Parents/carers are required to provide private transport to and from the Deakin 2 (6 Makin Place, Deakin). A supervising teacher will meet students at the venue.

Contingency: In the event of wet weather, the carnival might be postponed.

Behavioural expectations: Students will be expected to uphold our Duffy School values of being Respectful, Responsible and Inclusive whilst on this excursion.

What to bring:

- Water
