The following details relate to an educational excursion to National Museum of Australia which is being organised for Year 4

Purpose of excursion: Students will gain an understanding of what life was like in Australia pre 1788. As part of our Connected World unit of inquiry, students will use the knowledge gained to create a personal inquiry into different perspectives from around Australia and how life has changed.
