

Pump Track Permission Note

Dear Parents/Carers,

Duffy Primary School is pleased to announce that our pump track will be open in the coming weeks and ready for students to use throughout the school day. We will organise a roster designed to encourage new riders into the sport and allow experienced riders to practise their skills in a controlled setting. The intention for this track is for it to be used on occasional mornings and during lunch times using a roster system to allow full participation for all grades.

All students interested in using our pump track MUST:

- Have access to their own roadworthy bicycle which is suitable for riding on dirt and gravel.
- Have a working helmet that meets the Australian Standard for bicycle helmets (AS/NZS 2063:2020).
- Understand that there are risks associated with riding on a pump track and that they are doing so at their own risk.
- Follow all rules and instructions outlined by supervising teachers or members of staff to ensure their safety.
- Return this permission note prior to using the pump track.

There is to be no sharing of equipment when using the track as using unfamiliar equipment adds risk to the activity itself.
