Year 5 Combined Band Excursion Information for Parents

Dear parents and carers,

The following details relate to an educational excursion to **Chapman Primary School** which is being organised for Year 5 combined band practice.

Dates/time: Friday, 7 June 2024 9:30 am- 11.45am

Purpose of excursion: Year 5 Combined band practice

Activities: Along with Chapman Primary School, students will participate in the combined band. Sessions will include whole band rehearsals as well as sectionals (small group tuition) for each instrument group. Sessions are 90 minutes in total. There may be a short 'stretch your legs' break if time permits, but students will not eat, nor will they go onto the playground.

Clothing and Equipment: School uniform, instrument, music, and water bottle.

Transport: Bus

Cost: All costs are covered by the yearly band tuition payment.

Behavioural expectations: Students are expected to demonstrate our school values of being **Respectful**, **Responsible** and **Inclusive** at all times during this excursion.

What to pack/bring:

- Instrument & music (percussion students need their percussion bags with glockenspiel etc)
- Water bottle

Please note: There will be no performance for this event, but later in the year, combined rehearsals will include a concert that parents/carers may attend.

Staff accompanying students on excursions will take all reasonable care while the students are in their charge to protect them from injury and to control and supervise their behaviour and activities.
